[Downtown Historic Murals...](#) The Historic Downtown area of Dawson are lined with several unique and interesting murals. These murals depict our historic past including several of our past buildings along with a parade from years gone by on the side of the Chamber building. The old train depot mural is shown on the Hill and Hill Warehouse downtown. Also on the corner of Main and Lee Street is a mural that contains historic landmarks. The landmark mural was paid for by donations from local citizens and artists. The donors names are hidden within the beautiful artwork in this interesting mural.

[Historic District...](#) Terrell County boasts a beautiful Historic District which features Queen Anne Victorian, Neo-Classical, and

other types of historic homes and buildings. Two buildings are listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

[Terrell County Courthouse...](#) One of the loveliest and the tallest courthouses in the state of Georgia is located here, in the heart of downtown Dawson. Built in 1892, it was designed by architect William A. Parkins in High Victorian style. The courthouse is Terrell County's most significant monument.

[Farmer's Market...](#) Each fall the Farmer's Market in Sasser boasts an abundance of pumpkins in the pumpkin patch and beautiful sunflowers in the fields. The summer provides for tons of watermelons ripe off of the vine. The roadside stand can be found along Highway 82/520 in Sasser with a wide range of fresh produce!
